

<b><u>ANAC Freshmen Students: Fall 2001</u></b>	
<p>The 2001 ANAC freshmen norms are based on the responses of 9,199 students at 16 baccalaureate colleges. Of Elon's 1,212 Fall 2001 first-time full-time freshmen, 1,048 participated in this survey (an 87% response rate).</p> <p><b>Some key findings are:</b></p>	<p><b><u>ANAC Schools Participating in CIRP 2001</u></b></p>

<b><u>Elon vs. ANAC</u></b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>More Elon students stated chances are they will be satisfied with their college choice (60% vs. 53%)</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Elon has more students who lived 100 or more miles from college (84% vs. 61%)</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Elon students come from a more affluent background (\$100,000 or more: 52% vs. 35%)</b></li> <li>▪ <b>As a first choice college, Elon was higher (77% vs. 72%)</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Elon students attend fewer public high schools (73% vs. 78%)</b></li> <li>▪ <b>More Elon students came from high schools that required community service (38% vs. 32%)</b></li> <li>▪ <b>More Elon students plan to obtain a master's (56% vs. 41%)</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Elon students stated they are less concerned about financing college (No concern financing: 49% vs. 34%)</b></li> <li>▪ <b>Elon was chosen more often for rankings in national magazines (16% vs. 12%)</b></li> </ul>
