for PK-12 Teachers - Week-long SUMMER SESSION 2008

A reading institute will be offered for PK-12 teachers/assistants to earn up to three (3) licensure renewal credits (or 30 hours) in reading. This series of reading workshops is offered to local teachers and teacher assistants through The Professional Development Academy at Elon University. *Sessions are free-of-charge.* Each session is interactive and hands-on with class participation required.
