Planning Around A PANDEMIC

The start to the 2020-21 year at Elon has certainly been unlike any other. There was excitement when we were informed that students would be returning back to campus. While those of us in Catholic Campus Ministry had been getting used to streaming Masses and Zoom meetings with students, it is hard to truly journey in faith and discipleship when everything is virtual.

At the same time, there was trepidation with COVID-19 continuing to spread. However, we did not let that stop us from having a vibrant ministry! We introduced some new guidelines around the celebration of in-person Mass and made some changes to our event planning. CCM President Maddie Gall shares some of her thoughts:

“Elon has done a great job preparing for our arrival, and, as an organization, CCM has placed student comfort at the top of the list, which I appreciated. Obviously, there have been so many changes to how we operate as a ministry, but these changes are necessary and do not stray from our mission. Our events are typically outside now to allow for better social distancing and we now have three weekend Masses so students can have more options. Even with all of these changes, our ministry and leadership team has thoughtfully prepared different ways to adjust our events to serve the students while also being very safe. There is so much to look forward to this

semester. As a senior, I am excited for fall retreat as this is one of my final large CCM events. I am also excited for what our team has planned, as we have created events intentionally to help the first-years find their home in CCM just as I did. Lastly, I am just excited to grow closer with the leadership team as they have so quickly become some of my closest friends at Elon.”

Regarding changes around planning, CCM Vice President Courtney Kollar added:

“Most of the adjustments I’ve made as a Servant Leader have been approached with a positive attitude. I feel there is a greater need to engage and support our community now more than ever. Whenever I meet new people and try to welcome them into our ministry, I cherish the fact that I can be near people at all. Some of the CCM meetings I’ve attended have been online (which was not too bad of a change), and in those meetings, our CORE Team constantly brainstorms ways how we can better serve our Elon Community in the midst of a pandemic. I have confidence that we’ll be able to alter events that promote safety, smaller numbers, and social distancing by hosting events outside and in larger locations and by catering food at events where we’ve normally cooked ourselves. While times are different now than they were in previous years, I keep my motivation high to still make it a great year.”

From Oak

to

Altar

As a child, I was always by my father's side. I'd try to help him do everything around the house from cutting the grass to building a new addition onto our home. I love building and making things. My favorite toy as a kid was Legos for this reason. When I entered religious life, I immediately developed a woodworking hobby. I felt the need to keep making things and getting my hands dirty. The very first project that I ever made was a Paschal Candle stand for our small friary chapel. It was awful! Most first attempts at anything new are. That first project was completed over 16 years ago.

One part of woodworking that I love is the use of hand tools. I tend to prefer the use of hand planes, handsaws, chisels, and other old-fashioned tools to power tools. There is something deeply meditative and almost prayerful in woodworking this way. I like to think that there is a strong similarity between these tools and techniques of working wood to the way that St. Joseph taught Jesus to do carpentry in Nazareth.

Since I first began woodworking, I have made dozens of things. But until now, I have never made another item that was to be used for Mass. Our current altar was built by the local Knights of Columbus in 1995. It has served our community very well all these years, but it is long past due for a replacement. Our altar needs to be stored in a closet after every Sunday Mass since we worship in a borrowed space. So, there is a need for portability and for the altar to be disassembled and reassembled regularly. I spent months trying to come up with a beautiful, easy to use, and sturdy design to meet our requirements.

Finally, I wanted to continue the tradition of all things "Elon oak." The name Elon means "oak" in Hebrew. Everything around here is oak tree-themed. Whenever an oak tree is felled on campus, whether for a construction project or from a storm, the wood is milled into lumber. This lumber is available for anyone to use to make things for the students or the university. It was clear that any new altar for Elon Catholic Campus Ministry needed to be made from Elon oak. The trees that gave our university its name now give the wood for the altar upon which God gives us His very self at every Mass. After nearly 100 hours of tough work (oak is very hard wood), our new altar is complete! It is with great pride that I give this altar to CCM to be a central part of our worshipping the Lord for decades to come.

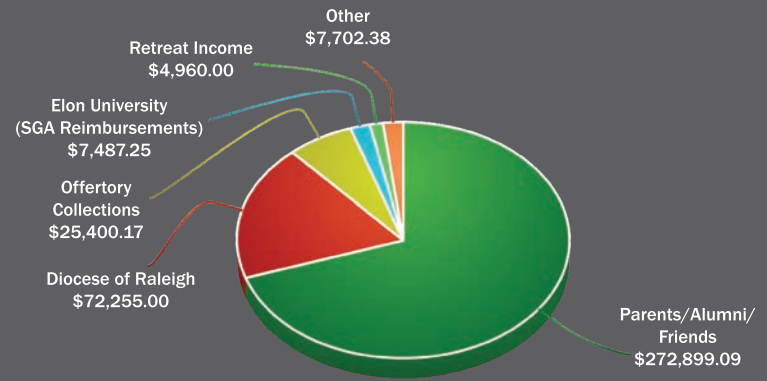

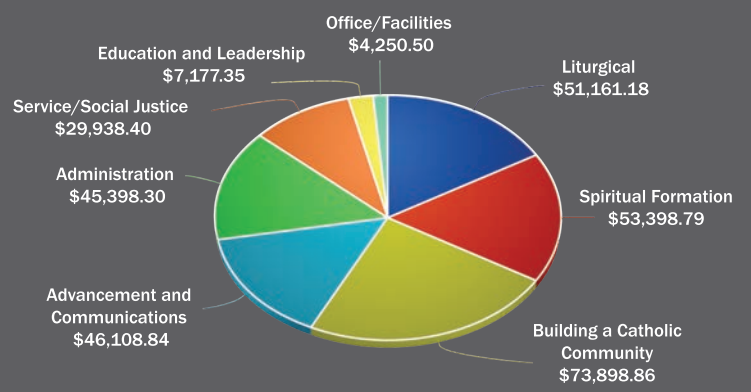

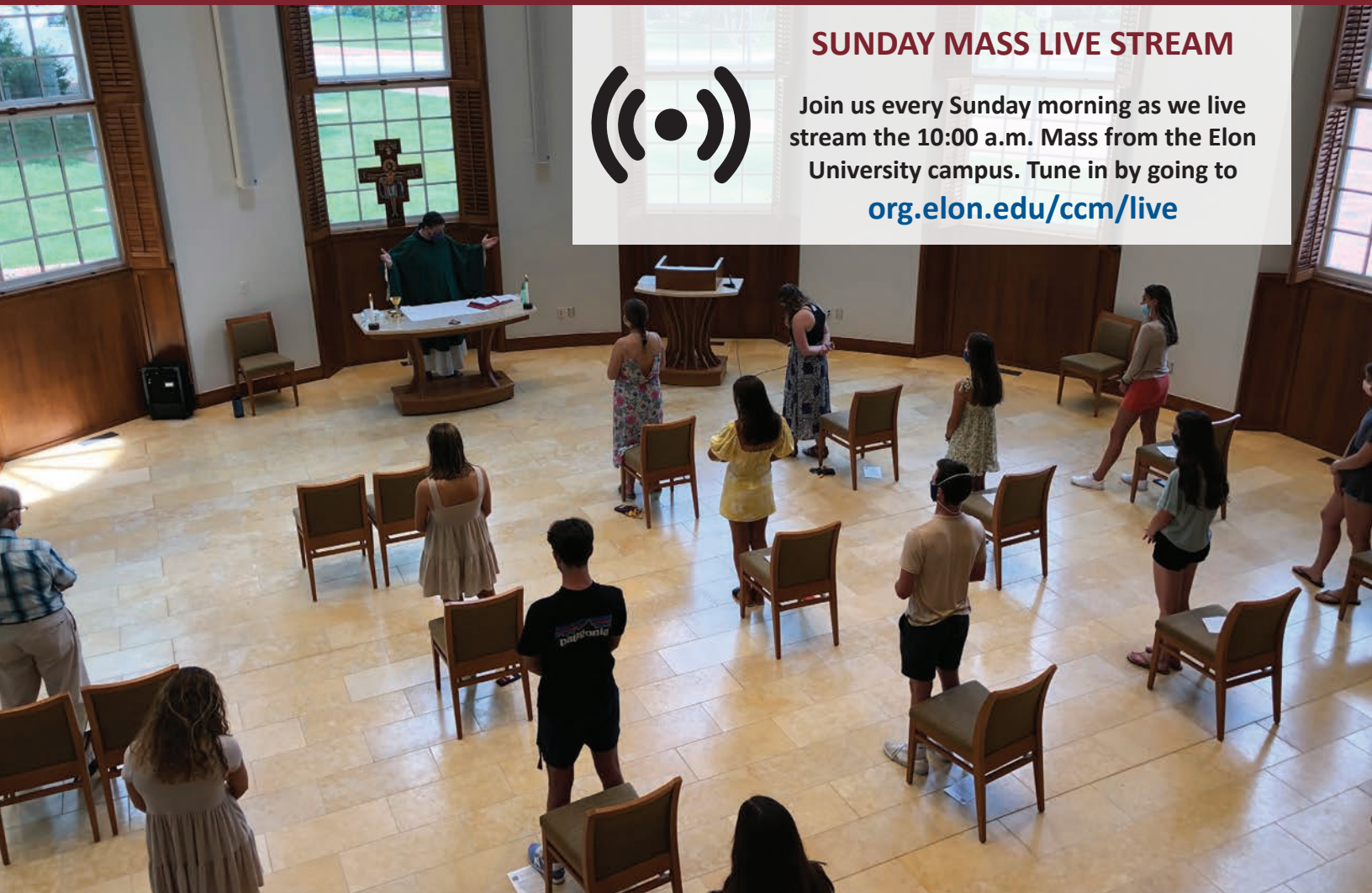
